Played by **Ezra Kelly**, Ivy is near the end of her training to become a nurse. Working here is the biggest test.

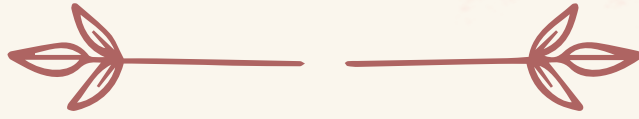
## **Maude Gallows – Cook**
